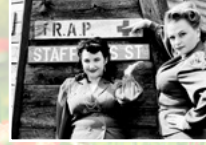

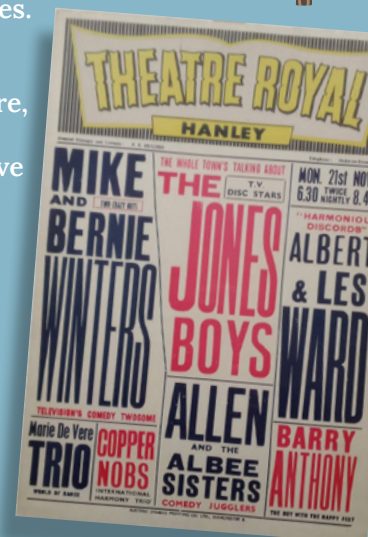
## Father's Day
