Relationship-based care

How we support you at home

Belong at Home is an affordable, high quality home care service where we cater to your needs rather than asking you to fit around ours. We provide a range of personal care, support and companionship services to enable you to continue living in your own home and community.



Personal care

Support with dressing, washing, meals, and taking medication.



Household help

Our team are able to assist with household chores, meal preparation, light cleaning, including changing bed linen and laundry services, and much more.



Belong companions

Enjoy a chat over a cuppa, discuss the daily news, or make the most of a friendly ear to listen to any concerns, with a dedicated Belong companion.



Hobbies & activities

Belong companions also help facilitate participation in hobbies and activities, either within your own home or garden, or out in your local community.



Wellbeing coaching

Help to get out and about and enjoy some fresh air, whether in your own garden or local neighbourhood. Belong at Home colleagues can also facilitate access to Belong's specialist gym service in your local village, where dedicated exercise specialists develop personalised exercise programmes.



Appointments & shopping

The team regularly support customers to attend appointments or to go shopping.



Personal assistants

Where needed, your home care team will provide assistance in facilitating electronic or video meetings with family and friends, e-consultations and telephone consultations, ordering shopping or medication online, organising blood tests.



Dementia expertise

We operate an Admiral Nurse service in conjunction with the charity, Dementia UK. This gives our customers and their families free access to registered mental health nurses who specialise in dementia and are able to provide advice and signpost further resources.



End-of-life care

We deliver compassionate support during challenging times. Belong is accredited under the Gold Standards Framework and is committed to ensuring people's wishes are acknowledged and respected at end-of-life.

Extended family in the wider Belong community

As part of the Belong family, customers can access their local Belong village facilities and vibrant events programme.

Village facilities include:

The Bistro - A place to relax with friends, family or neighbours, over a leisurely coffee or some fine dining.

The Venue - Join in with events, activities, and celebrations in our function room. Ask your home care team for the activity schedule at your local village or sign up to receive your own personal copy.

The Salon - Book an appointment at your local village and enjoy being pampered whilst enjoying a range of hair and beauty treatments.

The Gym - Your Belong team can support you to access your local Belong village gym which provides state-of-the-art equipment and technology alongside an exercise and rehabilitation service specifically geared towards improving the wellbeing of older people through tailored one-to-one programmes.

Subject to availability, all Belong at Home customers can benefit from a little extra support, if needed, with a short-stay break in one of our villages, and priority access to a longer-term stay if and when the time comes.

At Belong at Home, we believe that age shouldn't be a barrier to living out your dreams and aspirations, so we do our best to find out what matters to customers and translate these hopes into reality.

Our origins

Launched in 2009, Belong at Home is a sister brand of Belong villages, both operated by the not-for-profit organisation, Belong.

Working to redefine what's possible for older people, Belong's vision has led to the creation of an outstanding environment that integrates services, housing and community in a continually improving and innovative care model.

As a not-for-profit provider, Belong has been able to invest extensively in developing and honing this village model and all the services provided from this base. We are always exploring new opportunities, technologies and ideas that could make life better for those living with us.



Belong Macclesfield, opened in 2007, was the first location to pioneer the “Belong village” model.

Greater than the sum of its parts

Crucially, we bring together a number of vital aspects of care and housing to offer a unique proposition to those looking for support in later life.

Belong's services include:

- **Home care:** provided under the Belong at Home brand
- **Day care:** known as Experience Days
- **Independent living apartments:** co-located within Belong villages
- **Household living:** 24-hour care in smaller, homely settings
- **Nursing care:** available across all households due to our village nursing model
- **Dementia care:** all Belong colleagues receive dementia awareness training as a minimum to ensure we create dementia-friendly communities, with more advanced training for all frontline carers
- **Admiral Nurse access:** free customer access to our dementia specialist mental health nurses
- **Specialist exercise and rehabilitation service:** highly qualified exercise specialists work with Belong customers in our fully equipped gyms, providing a specialist service for older people with tailored 121 programmes
- **Village facilities:** such as a dementia-friendly bistro, hair salon and entertainment venue including a licensed bar
