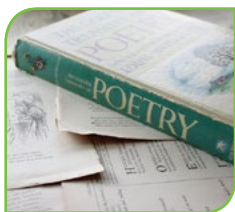

Seafood dining

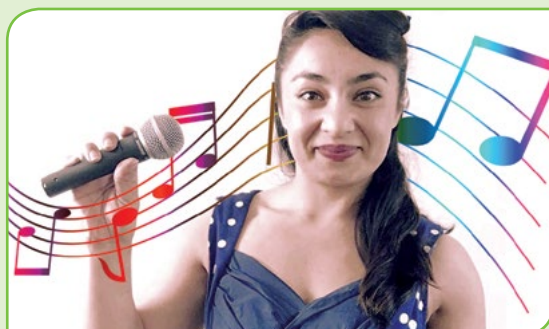
Come along to the first of our brand new pop-up restaurant evenings on Thursday 15 August.

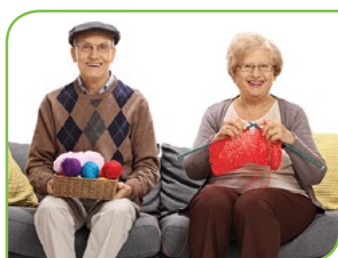


Coffee mornings
